



# SCIENTIFIC GUIDELINES

## **GENERAL GUIDELINES:**

- Registration at the 13<sup>th</sup> AOMSI Annual Karnataka State Chapter Conference is mandatory for Abstract Submission.
- All abstracts must be prepared according to the topics & guidelines provided.
- Name of the author / institution / hospital should not be mentioned in the abstract & manuscript.
- Incomplete or incorrect submissions will be rejected.
- All fields on the online abstract submission form must be completed.
- Submission of the abstract implies you have read, understood and comply with the terms and conditions as outlined in the abstract portal.
- Case reports will not be accepted under the prize category.

There will be seven topics for free paper and e-poster categories which are as follows-

- ✚ Cleft & Craniofacial surgery
- ✚ Orthognathic surgery
- ✚ Temporomandibular joint
- ✚ Oral cancer / Maxillofacial pathologies
- ✚ Maxillofacial trauma / Minor oral surgery
- ✚ Facial aesthetic surgeries
- ✚ Recent advances

- The best prize paper category will be awarded based on the Theme of the conference- “Evolving Concepts and Clinical Excellence”.
- Category of presentation should be chosen at the time of abstract submission and cannot be changed later.

Category 1	Free Papers for Post Graduates
Category 2	Prize paper for Post Graduates
Category 3	E-Poster for Post Graduates
Category 4	Free Papers for Delegates

- The necessary links for abstract and final submissions for prize paper, free paper and e-poster presentations will be provided. Kindly follow the link.
- One registered participant can present only one paper / one poster not both.

### **FREE PAPER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES**

- Time limit for free paper presentation is 6+2 minutes.
- The presentation should be done in power point and saved in .pptx format.
- Presentation should not include more than 15 slides.
- The presenters must be ready at the allotted slot, failing to which they may not be eligible for the presentation.
- All the presentations must be loaded in the preview area well in advance.
- No change in presenting author is allowed during free paper final sessions.
- Already published papers in journal will not be considered for presentation.
- All free paper certificates will be given to the presenting author only.
- Last date for submission of abstract is **10<sup>th</sup> August 2026**.
- Only one registered participant is allowed to present paper.

### **PRIZE PAPER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES**

- Time limit for prize paper presentation is 8+2 minutes.
- The best prize paper category will be awarded based on the Theme of the conference- “Evolving Concepts and Clinical Excellence”.
- Case reports will not be accepted under the prize category.
- Already published papers in journal will not be considered for presentation.
- The abstracts will be evaluated by the scientific committee and selected for the second round.
- The authors of these shortlisted candidates will be intimated.
- The presentation should be done in Power Point and saved in .pptx format.
- Presentation should not include more than 15 slides.
- The presenters must be ready at the allotted slot, failing to which they may not be eligible for the presentation.
- No change in presenting author is allowed during prize paper final sessions.
- The papers which are not shortlisted in the first and second rounds will be moved to the free paper category (category 1).
- Last date for submission of abstract is **20<sup>th</sup> July 2026**.

## **E - POSTER GUIDELINES**

- E-Posters should be uploaded as a 1page PDF/JPEG/Microsoft PowerPoint file in landscape orientation (16:9 ratio – Page setup).
- Date for uploading the e-poster will be intimated at a later date.
- Name of the presenter / institution / hospital should not be displayed.
- Registration number should be included while uploading the file.
- Pictures, tables or graphs can be included.
- Slide show / multiple slides not allowed.
- The use of music, video and ‘gif’ files is not allowed.
- Presentation time + Discussion = 2+2 minutes.
- All the e-posters will be judged and the best e-posters will be awarded.
- First and second prizes will be awarded under each session. One overall award will be chosen for the best conference e-poster.
- The presenters must be ready at the allotted slot, failing to which they may not be eligible for the prize.
- Participants are expected to carry a copy of the e-poster as a backup.
- E-Poster abstract submission is **10<sup>th</sup> August 2026**.
- Only one registered participant is allowed to present poster.

## **GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION**

- Submission of the abstract should be done through the website portal only.
- Select the appropriate category (1, 2, 3 & 4) before submitting the abstract.
- Abstract should be of 300 words including the title and references.
- Name of the author / institution / hospital should not be mentioned in the abstract.
- Only registration number should be mentioned.
- Abstract should be submitted under the IMRaD format.
- The last date for abstract submission is subject to the selected category of the abstract.
